Hello, Gentlemen! Monday night we rehearsed with Carolyn May and David Mouri for the narration and

I asked Don K to send around some audio files to help you rehearse. Please use them!! Jingle Bells- pretty good run through. Watch cut-offs. Rests are music too! (Sound familiar?)

Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree- have fun with this and perform for our audience!

Christmas Song- if we are singing it well, I may mess with the interp. Watch my conducting! Leads, sing lighter on the low notes and approach the high notes from above. Basses, there was a "blue" note that we pointed out last night, but I don't have my music in front of me to tell you which measure. I know the note is a Gb.

Little Saint Nick- "rush hour" tempo, not "cruising along the shoreline" tempo. Basses, we tend to drag in vs. 2. Use those rests as "surprise" breaths, while keeping your throats open and relaxed, of course. ;) I didn't say this last night, but please remember to sing on the "ee" vowel of

"Reindeeeeeee-r." Leave the "r" out until the cut-off.

Carol of the Bells- nice run through last night.

Good job executing the details we've been working on these last few weeks. Tenors and basses are dragging in the "ba ba dop, ba da ba dop," section. Use the surprise breath on those 8th rests to propel the music forward. Basses- practice the correct "ding dong" notes every day, every time you eat. Old Toy Trains- we worked on the syncopation of "old toy

Do You Hear What I Hear- we took some extra time to break this down. I hope I helped with my memory tips. Verse I- we sing unison until the last phrase in 4-part harmony with a tenor/lead pick-up; Verse 2-ladies lead, we echo (I WILL CUE YOU!); Verse 3- We sing in 4-part harmony until the last phrase which is sung unison (tenors on the octave); Verse 4- we alternate- ladies sing first, then we lead, then they lead,

then we lead, then we go to the close of the song.

The First Noel- Sing it all in one space/on one plane. We will raise the key to D#. Leads and basses, the tuning for this song is on you.

The Virgin Mary Had a Baby Boy- was a hot mess. Basses, you need to look at the music and practice verse 2 and chorus 2. I know the learning tracks are wrong in a lot of places, but they aren't wrong there. If nothing else, listen to just that verse and chorus. And while you're at it, practice your melody part on verse 3. I feel like we aren't completely comfortable with that entrance.

Silent Night- sounded pretty good Monday night. At least half of the leads sang the harmony for the last phrase instead of the melody. Good job! That is right.

We did not sing Adeste Fideles last night. We will need to work on that next week. In fact, in general I think the act one songs are stronger than the act two songs. I'd like to start with the act two songs next week, but with our guests who leave early, that's not very convenient. So, let's try to sing once through each act one song so that we can move on to the act two songs next Monday. Have a good week. Your practice outside of chorus makes a difference, so keep up the good work!
